



Notice of Race

The 2010, 29th Annual **Governor's Cup Regatta** will be held at the Portage County Park in the waters of Lake DuBay, Knowlton, WI on **August 21nd and 22rd, 2010.**

Hosts: The Organizing Authority is the **Lake DuBay Sailing Association.** See www.saildubay.org.

Class: Portsmouth and/or one design including but not limited to Scows (M-16, MC, I-20, etc.) Daggerboard (Butterfly, Sunfish, Laser, Force Five, etc), Day sailor (O-day, Flying Scot, Lightning, Interlake, etc) Catamaran, and Cruiser. Division is contingent on receipt of 4 or more valid registrations postmarked by August 1, 2010. Regardless of early registration, at least two divisions will be raced: Open Scow and Open Day Sailor.

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, (except as they are modified by the Sailing Instructions)

Eligibility: The regatta is open to all types of sailboats recognized by the 2010 Portsmouth handicap ratings. Boats not recognized in the 2010 Portsmouth handicap must be recognized in a previous Portsmouth handicap table in order to be properly rated and allowed to race.

Entry/Fees: Entries shall be submitted on the official registration form, which can be found on the RACING page of the Lake DuBay website: www.saildubay.org The entry fee is \$35 per boat. Boats whose registration form and fees are postmarked later than August 1st will be subject to a \$10 late fee. Entry fee includes racing fee, daily continental breakfasts, awards ceremonies, social activities and planned evening social events.

Completed registration forms, with the entry fee payable to Lake DuBay Sailing Association, shall be mailed to Vice-Commodore Valerie Charneski (address to follow). Lunches on Saturday and Sunday are available for all participants and LDBSA club members for an ala-carte fee. A Dinner will be held at the shelter Saturday evening for an ala-carte fee. Fees are listed on the registration form. **Payment for the lunches and dinner must be included with the pre-entry fee.**

Check-In: Check-in will be at the Portage County DuBay Park launch ramp from 0830 to 0930 on Saturday, August 21st. Each boat or representative must check-in to complete registration during this time frame.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be available at check-in. Amendments to the Sailing Instructions will be posted at the Portage Count Park launch ramp by 0930 hours daily.

Schedule of Races: A five race series with up to three races per day will be held on Saturday, August 21st. Remaining races will be held on Sunday, August 22nd. No more than three races per day will be sailed.

Scoring: The series will be scored as provided in Appendix A of the racing rules using the Low Point System.

Protests: A jury appointed by the Organizing Authority will hear protests and requests for redress.

Prizes: Series prizes will be awarded to three top places in each pre-registered class. The overall Governor's Cup traveling trophies will be awarded to the top three Portsmouth handicap places.
